It was open to Local Groups to take a table at £15 and it was resolved that MACDT would participate accordingly. Regards the Summer Gala Day, MACDT to organise this through Events Organiser JH. Trustees from Meigle Development Trust have proposed that MACDT take over assets belonging to them. This would include the community garden and financial assets from their bank account (est. £3,500 in funds). It was resolved that KS would reach out to Meigle Development Trust to discuss this further and speak to Sharon Connolly (Macnab's solicitors) to discuss any legal requirements.
